

Detecting Email Changes

DOMINO 8.5 READY

One topic that is commonly overlooked when talking about email security is email tampering. Leverage SecurTrac's ability to detect when an unauthorized person tampers with a corporate email to alter its content from its original state.

- Detect text changes in the Message body of an existing e-mail that has been updated.
- Results are stored on "Message Body - Text Changes" tab of the SecurTrac Mail Monitor log. This applies to Update actions only in the Mail Monitor.
- Ensure that no one has tampered with your company's sensitive emails in a user's mail database.

Mail Document Monitor Log - Update

While using the Domino Full Access Administration privilege, Peter Smith maliciously accessed the mail database of Jane Williams and changed the original content of an e-mail that she received.
